16 th January	Finishing with Foil Finishing with both metal (various colours) and real gold foils. Apply by 2 nd January	Maureen Duke
20 th February	Covering & Repairing Corners Includes making corners, ways of covering with variety of materials and also repairing corners Apply by 6 th February	Maureen Duke
19 th March	Beyond The Basics of Paper Repair A quick refresher on paper repairs followed by a look at adhesives and materials for completing more complex tears. Includes making re-moistenable tissue, consolidating tatty edges and tinting tissue. You are welcome to bring in a problematic paper project for discussion. Apply by 5 th March	Sonia Bradford
16 th April	Sharpening & Paring The varied tools used to pare leather and the means to keep them sharp. Apply by 2 nd April	David Mills
21 st May	Making Simple Finishing Tools Shape a finishing tool starting with a Brass rod. Apply by 7 th May	Maureen Duke
18 th June	Post Binding A simple sturdy loose leaf binding for documents and albums. Apply by 4 th June	Rachel Ward- Sale

Each Training Day costs £35 (payable in advance) and there will be an additional charge of £5.00 per person payable at each session for materials etc.

All courses take place at the club's bindery in Winchester and run from 10:30 to about 16:00
