These are intended for all levels of experience and ability although a basic understanding of bookbinding will be beneficial. They are limited to a maximum of eight students.

Date - Saturday	Title	Tutor
17 th September	Decorative End & Cover Papers A screenprinting technique to apply images to leather, bookcloth and paper. Apply by 3 rd September	Janine Pope
15 th October	End Papers 6 types (Tipped on, sewn on, made, cloth/leather jointed, zigzag, ledger). Apply by 1 st October	Maureen Duke
19 th November	Illustrative Onlays Shapes or patterns from book illustrations. Apply by 5 th November	Maureen Duke
10 th December	Edge Decoration From basic sprinkling and sponging through graphite, marbling, paste, gaufering and gold leaf. Apply by 26 th November	Kate Holland

Each Training Day costs £35 (payable in advance) and there will be an additional charge of £5.00 per person payable directly to the Tutor at each session for materials etc.

All courses take place at the club's bindery in Winchester and run from 10:30 to about 16:00
